- i. Issue an appropriate Writ of Mandamus directing the respondents to make arrangements for the proper water supply and make arrangement of the public toilets to the residents of the Block A, B and C of Sector – 15, JJ Colony, Dwarka, New Delhi.*
- ii. Issue an appropriate Writ directing the respondent no.3 to initiate inquiry in the improvement work done by contractor in pipeline of the Block A, B and C of Sector -15, JJ Colony, Dwarka, New Delhi.*
- iii. Pass such other or further order / orders which this Hon’ble Court may deem fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case.”*
