After some hearing, the learned counsel for the petitioner fairly concedes that the impugned order passed by the first appellate court on 19.01.2019 falls within the judicial discretion vested in the said court under Section 389 Cr.P.C., as indeed being in *sync* with the letter and spirit of Section 148 of Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881, and consequently submitted that he does not press for any relief in the nature of waiver of such deposit as has been directed by the first appellate court.
