1. The petitioners have filed the present petition, *inter alia*, praying that FIR bearing no. 0558/2018, under Sections 365/34 of the IPC registered with PS Mundka and all proceedings emanating therefrom, be quashed.
2. The said FIR was registered at the instance of respondent no. 2.
3. Respondent nos. 2 and 3 are present in Court and identified by the Investigating Officer.
