ORDER

The petitioner seeks parole to attend and perform customary rituals for the marriage of his niece (his sister's daughter) which is scheduled on 20.02.2019 in District Rohtak, Haryana. The address, as furnished by him, and the factum of the scheduled marriage have been verified. His conduct in jail is stated to be satisfactory. He has also been granted furlough and parole six times and has not misused the liberty.

In view of the above, the petitioner is granted parole for a period of four weeks from the date of his release on his furnishing a personal bond in the sum of Rs.10,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the Jail Superintendent concerned, subject to the following conditions:-

- (1) The petitioner shall report to the concerned SHO once a week during the period of parole.

- (2) He shall furnish his telephone number to the SHO concerned, which the petitioner shall keep operational at all times.
- (3) He shall not leave the territory of NCT of Delhi.
- (4) The petitioner shall surrender before the Jail Authorities at the expiry of the period of parole.

With the above directions, the writ petition stands disposed-off.

A copy of this order be given *dasti* to the learned counsel for the parties and a copy be sent to the Jail Superintendent concerned, for compliance.
