Issue notice. Learned counsel for the respondent Union of India accepts notice.

In view of the order that we propose to pass, no counter-affidavit is called for in the present matter.

The petitioner has preferred this writ petition to assail the order dated 12.09.2018 passed in O.A. No. 2302/2016 titled *Rajendra Singh Vs. Union of India* before the Central Administrative Tribunal, Principal Bench, New

Delhi (CAT/ Tribunal). The Tribunal passed the common impugned order in the five Original Applications, including O.A. No. 2561/2015. The decision in O.A. No.2561/2015 was carried to this Court in appeal in W.P. (C.) No. 12896/2018. Vide order dated 06.12.2018 passed in W.P. (C.) No.12896/2018, the matter was remanded back to the Tribunal.

Accordingly, we dispose of the present matter in terms of our order dated 06.12.2018 in W.P. (C.) No. 12896/2018 and remand the Original Application back to the Tribunal in the same terms.

The parties shall appear before the Tribunal on 28.03.2019.

The petition stands disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
