The question of naming of a road and describing it in the memory of a particular person is an executive matter based on policy decisions of the Executive and a writ court exercising extraordinary jurisdiction under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is not required to go into all these aspects of the matter.

We see no merit in the writ petition and the same is dismissed.

The petitioner may approach the authorities and it is for the authorities to look into the grievance of the petitioner.
