1. Allowed, subject to all just exceptions.

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2. Learned counsel for the Petitioner states that the substantial portion of the refund claim has been rejected by the Respondents. He further states that no order setting out the reasons for such rejection have been issued to him thus far. Also no decision has been taken on the grant of interest on the refund amount allowed.

3. This Court directs the Respondents to provide to the Petitioner the reasons for rejection of the refund and also pass an order on the interest for the refunds granted not later than 30th September, 2019. It will be open thereafter for the Petitioner to seek appropriate remedies in accordance with law.

4. The petition is disposed of with the above directions
