However, the SHO, Police Station Vivek Vihar, Delhi, is directed to ensure that no bodily harm or injury is caused to the petitioner- Pradeep as well as his wife Ms.Khushi @ Khushboo residing at H. No. 193-A, Gali No. 1, Ramlila Ground, Shahdara, Delhi - 110032. The beat constable of the concerned area is directed to give his as well as concerned SHO's mobile number to the petitioner. In the event of any emergency, the petitioner would be entitled to get in touch with them.
