Vide the present application, the applicant/complainant seeks direction thereby to take on record the additional facts. It is stated in the present application that the applicant/complainant has now planned to arrive in India and she will be available from 15.10.2019 to 24.10.2019 in India. Accordingly, she is willing to depose before the learned Trial Court during the aforesaid period.

Considering the fact that the matter is more than 10 years old and there is already a direction from the Hon'ble Supreme Court vide order dated 11.02.2019 to expedite the trial of the case, this Court directs the Trial Court to fix two consecutive dates between 15.10.2019 to 24.10.2019 for cross-examination of the applicant.
