Vide the present petition, the petitioners seek direction thereby quashing FIR No. 309 /2016 registered at PS – Jait Pur for the offences punishable under Sections 323/452/34 IPC.

The present petition is filed on the ground that the parties have amicably settled their disputes in the Mediation Centre, Saket Courts, New Delhi and the respondent No. 2 has no objection if the present petition is allowed.

Respondent No. 2 is personally present in Court with learned counsel – Mr. Deepak Agarwal and he has been identified by SI Prateek Saxena/IO.

Learned counsel for the respondent No. 2 submits that the respondent No. 2 has received the total settlement amount and has no objection if the present petition is allowed.

Keeping in view the settlement arrived at between the parties, I hereby quash the FIR No. 309 /2016 registered at PS – Jait Pur for the offences punishable under Sections 323/452/34 IPC and all other proceeding emanating therefrom.

Petition is accordingly allowed and disposed of.
