J U D G M E N T (O R A L)

Vide the present petition, the petitioner seeks direction thereby quashing FIR No. 853/2015 dated 18.08.2015, registered at PS – K.N. Katju Marg for the offences punishable under Sections 354/354(B)323/392/506/34 IPC and all other proceedings emanating therefrom.

With the consent of the counsel for the parties, the present petition is taken up for final disposal.
