Vide the present application, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in the event of his arrest in FIR No. 605/2019 registered at Police Station – Nahal Vihar for the offences punishable under Sections 308/34 IPC.

Keeping in view the fact the two accused have already been admitted on anticipatory bail by the Sessions Court and one accused has been granted anticipatory bail by this Court on 25.09.2019.

Accordingly, keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case and without commenting upon merits and demerits of the prosecution case, this Court is of the considered view that the present case is fit for

anticipatory bail.

The SHO/ Arresting Officer/IO concerned, is hereby directed that in the event of arrest, the petitioner/ applicant be released on bail on the following terms and conditions:-

(i) That the petitioner shall furnish a personal bond in the sum of ₹20,000/- with one surety in the like amount subject to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer/SHO/IO concerned;

(ii) That the petitioner shall cooperate with the investigation and make himself available for interrogation by police officer, as and when required;

In case of default of aforementioned conditions, the State is at liberty to take appropriate recourse in accordance with law.

Before parting with the order, it is relevant to mention that nothing contained in this order shall be construed as an expression on the merits of the case.

Application stands allowed and disposed of.
