Learned counsel for the petitioner has drawn my attention to the order dated September 10, 2019 passed by the Arbitral Tribunal wherein in Para 4, the Tribunal has stated as under:

“4. In the aforesaid circumstances, the Tribunal is not inclined to move the Hon'ble Court for assistance in taking evidence.
