1. Learned APP under instructions informs that Section 313 IPC has been added during the pendency of these proceedings consequent to medical opinion received.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner prays that he may be permitted to withdraw the petition with liberty to file a fresh petition seeking bail inter-alia under Section 313 IPC. He prays that the interim protection granted to the petitioner be extended by a period of 10 days to enable him to file an appropriate application before the competent Court.
3. In view of the above, petition is dismissed as withdrawn.

4. The interim protection granted to the petitioner is extended by a period of 10 days to enable the petitioner to apply to the competent Court.
