Vide this petition, petitioner is praying for extension of parole for a further period of six weeks on the ground that surgery of his daughter is scheduled for 15th November, 2019 and he has to arrange for blood and also because there is no other male member in the family to take care of her. Petitioner is in custody in FIR No. 139/2004, registered at police station Mangol Puri, Delhi and FIR No. 119/2004, registered at police station Shalimar Bagh, New Delhi.
