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3. Vide the present petition, the petitioner seeks direction thereby quashing FIR No. 109/2017 dated 27.04.2017, registered at PS – Delhi Cantt. and all other proceedings emanating therefrom.

7. The present petition is filed on the ground that the parties have settled their disputes and the respondent no.2 has no objection if the present petition is allowed.
