3. The petitioner states that he had made an application seeking parole on 14.10.2019, however, that application has not been decided as yet.

4. Mr Lao, learned ASC points out that the petitioner had filed a similar petition (W.P.(Crl.) 3071/2019) seeking similar relief, which was dismissed on 01.11.2019. The said fact has not been mentioned in the present petition.
