This is an application under Section 36 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996. The Learned Additional Solicitor General submits that vide order dated 14th March, 2018, the impugned award was stayed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court, till the final disposal of the matter. The judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court has now been rendered and it has been held that the Section 34 petition before this Court is maintainable.
