It is submitted that petitioners and respondent tno.2 have settled their disputes amicably before the Delhi High Court Mediation & Conciliation Centre on 04.02.2019. Learned counsel for respondent no.2 says that respondent no.2 has no objection in case complaint case no. 532/1/2011 under Section 451/323/341/506/34 IPC titled Naveen Aggarwal Vs. Ashok Sharma pending in the court of Ld. Metropolitan Magsitrate-01/West, Tis Hazari Court, Delhi is quashed in view of the settlement.

In view of the settlement arrived at between the petitioners (accused) and respondent no.2 (complainant), I am of the view that no fruitful purpose would be served in keeping the criminal complaint pending. Accordingly, in
