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1. The learned counsel appearing for respondent nos. 4 and 5 states that the controversy involved in the present petition has been rendered academic, since respondent nos. 4 and 5 has sought to withdraw their licenses, under the provisions of Bureau of Indian Standards (Conformity Assessment) Regulations, 2018 and pursuant to their request, Bureau of Indian Standards has, by the letters dated 03.01.2019, informed the respondents that their respective licenses have been cancelled.
