1. The petitioner has filed the present petition, *inter alia*, praying that the respondent's petition – case No.125/18, captioned ***Gauri v. Davesb Kumar***, which is pending before Sh. Manoj Kumar, ADJ 08 (District Central), Tis Hazari Court, be transferred to the Family Court, District Central, Tis Hazari Court, Delhi. The petitioner has filed a divorce petition being HMA No.5861809/2016, captioned ***Davesb Kumar v. Gauri***, which is currently pending before the Family Court District Central, Tis Hazari Court, Delhi and is now fixed on 19.07.2019.

2. Undisputedly, some if the issues involved are common, therefore, the present petition is allowed and the case No.125/18, captioned ***Gauri V. Davesb Kumar***, pending before Sh. Manoj Kumar, ADJ 08 (District Central), Tis Hazari Court, is transferred to the Family Court, District

Central, Tis Hazari Court, Delhi.

3. The parties are directed to appear before the concerned court on 31.05.2019.

Learned counsel appearing for the respondent states that the interest of the mother of the petitioner was also protected in the proceedings inasmuch as FDRs held in the joint name of the petitioner and his mother have been protected.
