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1. Learned counsel for the Respondents does not dispute that both these writ petitions can be disposed of in terms of the order dated 22nd January, 2019 passed by this Court in W.P.(C) No.641/2019 (*Ex.-Head Constable/GD Sanjeev Kumar v UOI*).
