JUDGMENT

SANJEEV SACHDEVA, J. (ORAL)

1. Petitioner impugns order dated 24.04.2018, whereby, leave to defend application of the petitioner has been dismissed and an eviction order passed.

2. Respondent had filed the subject eviction petition seeking eviction of the petitioner, on the ground of bonafide necessity under Section 14(1) (e) of the Delhi Rent Control Act, 1958, from Property No.531, Ground Floor, Kucha Pati Ram, Bazar Sita Ram, Delhi-110006, Delhi, more particularly as shown in red colour in the site

plan annexed with the petition.

3. Parties were referred to mediation.
