During the course of hearing, respondent no. 2 has admitted that matter was settled between her and the petitioners during the hearing of bail applications of petitioners, inasmuch as, settled amount of ₹25 lacs stands paid to her before the trial court but in installments. Respondent no. 2 says that petitioners delayed the payments, therefore, she may be compensated by paying ₹1.50 lacs by the petitioner towards the delayed payment.
