1. The counsel for the parties, in this suit for permanent injunction restraining infringement of trade mark and passing off and for ancillary reliefs and in which an interim injunction in favour of the plaintiff is in force, state that the parties have settled all their disputes subject matter of this suit on the terms contained in IA No.477/2019 under Order XXIII Rule 3 of the CPC.
