ORDER

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23.01.2019

The petitioner has surrendered before the Jail Authorities after availing bail for four days granted to him. He seeks regular bail. In the present case, four persons are accused; allegations against all are similar; three co-accused have already been granted bail. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that one of the accused has been killed by the complainant and the latter has been punished for life imprisonment vide order dated 05.01.2019 in FIR No. 94/2018 registered at Police Station, K.N.K. Marg, Delhi over whom the petitioner can have no sway.

The learned counsel for the State submits that of the 15 witnesses, 9 witnesses have been examined. The remaining witnesses are police officials.

In the aforesaid circumstances, the petitioner is granted bail on his furnishing a personal bond in the sum of Rs. 25,000/- with one surety of the

like amount to the satisfaction of the Trial Court concerned, subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) the petitioner will regularly appear on each and every date of hearing to be fixed by the Trial Court concerned;
- (ii) the petitioner will not try to influence, contact or meet the complainant and prosecution witnesses in any manner;
- (iii) the petitioner will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court and the passport, if any, shall be deposited with the Trial Court concerned; and
- (iv) in case of change of his new address or contact number, the petitioner will promptly intimate to the SHO/IO of the case and intimate the Trial Court.

The petition stands disposed-off in the above terms.

Nothing stated in this order shall be deemed to be an adjudication on the merits of the case.

The Registry is directed to send a copy of this order to the Jail Superintendent, concerned for compliance. Additionally, a copy of the same shall also be delivered upon the Jail Superintendent through the police.

A copy of this order be given *dasti* to the learned counsel for the parties under the signature of the Court Master.
