ORDER

1. Mr Ramesh Singh, learned counsel appearing for the respondent submits that subsequent to the filing of the present petition, the respondents have passed a fresh order dated 28.05.2018 after affording the petitioner an opportunity to be heard. He states that in the aforesaid view, the order impugned in the present petition no longer survives.
