This is an application for grant of anticipatory bail filed by the applicant/petitioner under Section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.

Learned counsel for the petitioner prays for bail to the petitioner on the ground that the petitioner is suffering from chronic diabetes and the same has affected his eyes. The petitioner is presently undergoing treatment of detachment of retina.
