1. Petitioner impugns order dated 24.05.2018 whereby the maintenance amount to be paid to the respondent was enhanced from Rs. 20,000/- to Rs. 35,000/-.

2. Parties were referred to mediation. Parties have settled their disputes through the process of mediation at Delhi High Court Mediation & Conciliation Centre. Settlement Agreement dated 21.02.2019 has been executed between the parties.

3. The parties are present in Court in person. They acknowledge the settlement agreement and undertake to abide by the terms and conditions therein.

4. As per the settlement, an account is to be opened under Sukanya Samriddhi Yojana in the name of the minor child. Parties

further agree that the said account shall be opened on or before 15.03.2019.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the settlement agreement and the undertaking that the respondent shall abide by the terms and conditions herein, he seeks leave to withdraw the petition.

6. The petition is accordingly dismissed as withdrawn. The parties shall be bound by the terms and conditions of the settlement agreement dated 21.02.2019.
