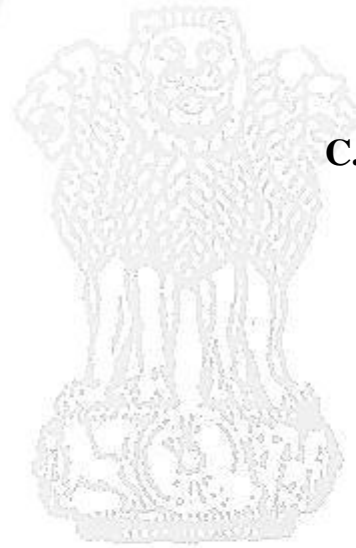
counsel for the respondent, he is not able to find any discrepancy in the manner in which marks have been awarded.
