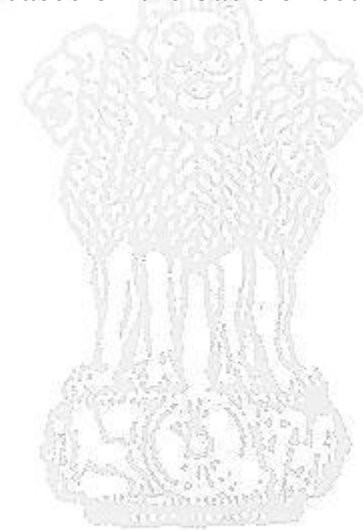
Since both these petitions arise out of one FIR, therefore, with the consent of the counsel for the parties, they have been heard together and are being disposed of by this common order.
