I.A. 7193/2019 (this is a joint application on behalf of the parties under Order 23 Rule 3 CPC)

1. The application has been duly signed by the representatives of the parties and also by the counsels present before the Court today. Both the counsels support the settlement. The terms of the settlement, are set out in para 4 of the application. The parties jointly prayed for the suit to be decreed in terms of the settlement recorded in para 4 of the application.
