1. These petitions were filed against certain interim orders passed by the Central Administrative Tribunal ('CAT') during the pendency of the main OA Nos. 3098/2016, 3099/2016 & 3100/2016. In the present petitions, it

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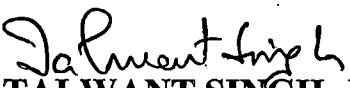
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was directed by this Court that the repatriation of the Petitioners to the National Highway Authority of India (NHAI) would be subject to the outcome of these petitions.
