4. Learned counsel for the Respondent, on instructions, states that, on the previous occasions, the exercise took no less than six months to complete the process but this time they require more time.

5. The Court issues a direction to the Committee constituted by the order dated 2<sup>nd</sup> February, 2018 to endeavour to complete the cadre review exercise entrusted to it within a period of six months from today. If there is any inordinate delay in the Committee concluding the cadre review exercise, it will be open to the Petitioners to approach the Court again for relief.

6. The petition is disposed of in the above terms.
