1. The parties have amicably resolved their disputes through mediation. The terms of the settlement are recorded in the settlement agreement dated 14th February, 2019 which is marked as Ex.C-1. The parties have also filed joint application I.A. 2506/2019 under order XXIII Rule 3 of the Code of Civil Procedure for recording of the settlement and passing a decree in terms thereof.
2. The settlement between the parties is lawful and is recorded. The suit is decreed in terms of the Ex.C-1 which shall form part of the decree.
3. Learned counsel for the plaintiffs has handed over two bankers cheque totalling Rs.12,50,000/- to counsel for the defendant. The plaintiffs undertake that aforesaid bankers' cheque shall be honoured upon presentation. The statement is taken on record.
