plaintiff and defendants as well as by the parties to the litigation.

Present application is also supported by affidavits of the plaintiff and the defendants.

Learned counsel for parties state that the matter has been compromised in accordance with the terms mentioned in the order dated 07th February, 2019 and I.A. 3132/2019.

Today, learned counsel for defendants No.1, 3 and 4 has handed over the following bank drafts to learned senior counsel for plaintiff totalling to Rs.30 lacs (Rupees Thirty Lacs Only):-

With the aforesaid observations, present application is allowed and the suit and counter-claim as well as all pending applications stand disposed of.
