The petitioner is claiming status of wife as against respondent No.3 and prays that service benefits according to her husband be made available to her and she should be included as a nominee. The services relating to Railways are to be examined as

per the Administrative Tribunal Act, 1985 by the Central Administrative Tribunal. In the case of **L. Chandra Kumar Vs. Union of India & Ors., reported in (1997) 3 SCC 261**, the Supreme Court has held that administrative jurisdiction lies exclusively with the Central Administrative Tribunal.

The writ petition for such claims would not lie and the same is dismissed with liberty to the petitioner to file an Original Application before the CAT.
