ORAL ORDER

2 23-01-2020 The petitioner is seeking a direction to the respondents to publish his name in the final result/ select list and appoint him on the post of Health and Malaria Inspector Grade-III under Railway, under the Union of India. The petitioner has a remedy under the Administrative Tribunal Act, 1985 by approaching the Central Administrative Tribunal.

This writ application cannot be maintained in view of the Supreme Court's decision in case of *L. Chandra Kumar vs. Union of India and others* reported in (1997) 3 SCC 261 and is accordingly dismissed.

The petitioner shall have the liberty to approach the Central Administrative Tribunal for the relief, which he has



sought in the present writ application.
