ORAL ORDER

2 25-02-2020 It is the petitioner's case that a proceeding under Bihar Public Land Encroachment Act, 1956 initiated vide Encroachment Case No. 07 of 2019-20 by the Circle Officer, Khagaria Circle is still pending and is not being expeditiously disposed of. It is her further case that the land, which has been



encroached upon by private persons, is a public land of the nature of public road.

Considering the nature of relief, which the petitioner is seeking, this application is disposed of with an observation that let Encroachment Case No. 07 of 2019-20 be disposed of expeditiously preferably within a period of six months from the date of receipt/ production of a copy of this order.
