counsel for the respondents.

Petitioner has prayed for the following relief(s).

“A. For issuance of appropriate writ/order or direction for declaration of clause (Para) 4/4.9 of the Anganbari Supervisor/Sevika/Sahaika Selection guidelines as ultra vires constitution of India by which it has been provided the “Bahu” of a Govt. Servant will not be



eligible for appointment as Anganbari Sevika.

B. For issuance of appropriate writ/order or direction commanding the respondents authorities to cancel the selection of the respondent no. 8 as Anganbari Sevika in Nimuya Gram Panchayat, Ward No. 6, Centre No. 241, Block Majhagarh, District- Gopalganj.

C. For issuance of appropriate writ/order or direction commanding the respondent authorities to select/appoint the petitioner as Anganbari Sevika on the said centre no. 241; ward no. 6 in Gram Panchayat Nimuya, Block Majhagarh, District- Gopalganj.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition reserving liberty to file a petition afresh on the same and subsequent cause of action.

Prayer allowed.

The petition stands dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.
