Petitioner has prayed for the following relief(s):

“i) Issuance of a writ of certiorari quashing the order, dated 24.08.2016, passed by the Commercial Tax Officer, Aurangabad Circle, Aurangabad, by which an ex parte order of assessment has been passed against the petitioner under section 31 of the Bihar Value Added Tax Act, 2005 for the assessment year 2015-16 assessing the petitioner for payment



of VAT of Rs. 206000.00;

ii) Quashing and setting aside the consequential demand notice, dated 24.8.2016, by which the petitioner has been directed to pay a sum of Rs.185,000.00 upon adjusting the admitted tax already paid by the petitioner;

iii) To pass such other order(s) as your lordships may deem fit and proper in the interest of justice and equity.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the petition.

The petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
