2 23-01-2020 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in connection with
Kursakanta P.S. Case No. 4 of 2019, registered for offence
punishable under Sections 341, 323, 494, 498(A), 379 and 34 of
the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner
submits that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been
implicated in the present case. Further submission is that from
perusal of FIR, it appears that there is no demand of dowry. The
petitioner has no criminal antecedent and he is in custody since
17.12.2019.



Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions advanced on behalf of the parties, let the above-named petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-Vth, Araria in connection with Kursakanta P.S. Case No. 04 of 2019.
