2 20-01-2020 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the

learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioner is in custody since 22.07.2019 in
connection with Naubatpur P.S. Case No.484 of 2019
registered for the offence under Sections 25(1-b)a/26/35 of the
Arms Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner was arrested on false premise from Punpun Railway
Station stating that certain arms had been recovered from the
house of the petitioner. Learned counsel further submits that
the house from which such recoveries are alleged to have been
made are joint possession of the family and therefore cannot
be saddled on his shoulders. Learned counsel further submits
that prior to the institution of the present case, the petitioner



has clean past, but has been subsequently remanded to two such cases.

Considering the aforementioned facts and circumstances, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on his furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-II, Danapur, Patna, in connection with Naubatpur P.S. Case No.484 of 2019.
