2 11-06-2020 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as
learned APP through video conferencing.

After having been informed by an Excise Official regarding indulgence of petitioner in carrying sale of wine near his house, police swung into action, came at the location where none was present. One bag was lying in abandoned condition and after opening the same, 7.7 litres of whisky was found therein. The house of the petitioner lies 400 metres away from there which was searched out but nothing incriminating has been recovered from his house. The local inhabitants disclosed that the seized wine belongs to the petitioner.

Considering the nature of the allegation so propounded at the end of prosecution, let petitioner, **RAMA SHANKAR SINGH** be released on anticipatory bail in the



event of arrest or surrender within four weeks on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Additional Sessions Judge-2nd-cum-Special Judge, Excise Act, Saran at Chapra in connection with Masrakh P.S. Case No. 517 of 2019, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
