The petitioner prays for release of the vehicle, namely, Bolero bearing registration no. JH01AS-0477 seized in connection with Amba P.S. Case No. 35 of 2019 for the offences punishable under Section 30(A) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner invites our attention to the order dated 9<sup>th</sup> January, 2020 passed in CWJC No. No.20598 of 2019 titled as Md. Shaukat Ali Vs. The State of Bihar & Ors. and prays for disposal in terms thereof.

As such, as prayed for, on mutually agreed terms, we dispose of the present petition in terms of the order dated 9<sup>th</sup> January, 2020 passed in CWJC No. No.20598 of 2019 titled as



Md. Shaukat Ali Vs. The State of Bihar & Ors. making the terms contained therein, applicable mutatis mutandis, insofar as applicable, also to the instant petition. The terms of the said order shall be deemed to have been incorporated and read as a part and parcel of the present order.

It shall be obligatory on the part of the instant parties to place on record of the authorities under the provision of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016, a copy of not only the order passed in the instant petition, but also that of CWJC No. No.20598 of 2019 titled as Md.
