2 26-06-2020 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection with Yogapatti (Nawalpur) P.S. Case No. 220 of 2019 for the offence registered under Sections 341, 323, 324, 325, 307, 448, 504 and 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners submits that petitioners are innocent and have falsely been implicated in connection with the present case. It is further submitted that there is case and counter case between the parties and both the parties sustained injuries. It is further submitted that the petitioners have no criminal antecedents.



Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioners be released on bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing personal bail bond to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bettiah, West Champaran in connection with Yogapatti (Nawalpur) P.S. Case No. 220 of 2019, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
