ORAL ORDER**

3 15-06-2020 The matter has been taken up through Video
Conferencing.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case
registered for the offences punishable under Sections 364, 323,
324, 307/34, 302 and 120B/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The petitioner had lodged Jehanabad P.S. Case No.
619 of 2019 under Sections 379 and 511 of the Indian Penal
Code alleging therein that three thieves were attempting to stole
away his Submersible Pump Set. One of the thieves was
apprehended by the villagers. His name was Rakesh Kumar.
Rakesh Kumar was bitterly assaulted by the villagers and he
was getting treatment in the hospital. Thereafter, the present FIR
was lodged by the father of said Rakesh Kumar alleging therein



that one Bikesh Yadav and Makai Yadav had took Rakesh Kumar along with them and thereafter some one reported that dead body of his son was lying in the field side. The informant further got information that the victim was taken for treatment by the police to the hospital where dead body was found.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that considering the aforesaid background co-accused Sudhir Singh has been allowed anticipatory bail by a Coordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 04.03.2020 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 11550 of 2020.

Considering the entire facts aforesaid especially no direct material against the petitioner, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of thirty days from the date of receipt of the order, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (rupees twenty thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending in connection with Jehanabad (Karauna) Town Police Station Case No. 622 of 2019, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure as well as subject to the following conditions:-



(a) The petitioner shall fully cooperate with the investigation/trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.

(b) Both the bailors shall be resident of the territorial jurisdiction of the learned court below.

(c) The petitioner shall not leave the country without permission of the trial court.
