ORAL ORDER

2 29-02-2020 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioners are apprehending arrest in connection with Hayaghat P.S. Case No. 90 of 2018 for the offences under Sections 341, 323, 324, 448, 354(B) and 379 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have no criminal antecedent. He further submits that allegation against the petitioner is that they were involved in abusing and assaulting the informant with fists and slaps.

Considering the fact that the petitioners have no criminal antecedent, the Court is inclined to grant bail to the



petitioners, in the event of arrest or surrender within four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.25,000/- (Twenty Five Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Darbhanga in connection with Hayaghat P.S. Case No. 90 of 2018, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, with further condition that both the bailors shall be female of the locality.
