2 06-01-2020 The petition filed on 11.10.2018 is listed for hearing
for the first time today before the Court.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the respondents.

Petitioner has prayed for the following relief/s:

“For direction to the respondent no.4 to remove the
encroachment over the Gramin road spreading in
different khata nos. and Khesra nos. in Borra
Pathakdih Panchayat on the ground that the
internally connecting Gramin road constructed by
the Government under the scheme of Gramin Sadak
Yojana, has been encroached by the



encroachers/villagers of the locality causing immense impediment in crossing/passing through the Gramin Road. Alternatively, for direction to the respondent no.4 to proceed with the Land Encroachment Case No.02/2013-14 and conclude the same within the statutory period taking all the necessary steps to remove the encroachment from the aforesaid Gramin Road in Borra Pathakdih Panchayat.”

After the matter was heard for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner shall be content if a direction is issued to the concerned respondents to consider and decide the representation, which the petitioner shall be making afresh within a period of four weeks from today.

Learned counsel for the State states that upon receipt of such request, if any, the same shall be dealt with in accordance with law, expeditiously and positively within a period of three months from the date of receipt thereof.

Equally, liberty is reserved to the petitioner to take recourse to such alternative remedies as are otherwise available in accordance with law.

We are hopeful that as and when petitioner takes recourse to such remedies, as are otherwise available in law, before the appropriate forum, the same shall be dealt with, in



accordance with law and with reasonable dispatch.

The petition stands disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
