counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

Petitioner is in custody connection with Hathauri P.S.
Case No. 242 of 2018 for the offence under section 384 of the
Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
allegation against this petitioner is that he has demanded
Rangdari. He submits that there is no case that ransom was paid
to the petitioner.

The petitioner is in custody since 14.1.2019.

Considering the fact that petitioner has remained in
custody for more than one year, the Court is inclined to grant
bail to the petitioner, let the petitioner, named above, be



enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 50,000/- (Fifty thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Sri Deepak Kumar, learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Muzaffarpur, in connection with Hathauri P.S. Case No. 242 of 2018 subject to the condition that bailors should be family members of the petitioner.
